1. Introduction

2. Our services

This Privacy Policy governs how Fairbrics collect, use, disclose, transfer, and store your personal information.

We undertake to comply with the European General Data Protection Regulation No. 2016/679 applicable from 25 May 2018 (the "GDPR") and other French privacy laws.

Our Privacy Policy is intended to describe the security and confidentiality measures relating to your personal data implemented by Fairbrics.

1. Collection of your personal information

Personal data is information which may be used to identify or contact a specific person.

You may be required to provide personal data at any time when you are in contact with Fairbrics or its affiliates.
